





ST JOHN OF JERUSALEM EYE-HOPSITAL NEWS

Dear Knights,

The situation in the Holy Land continues to get worse and I'm sure you have been following those developments on the various news channels.

As I hope many of you will recall the title of our history is called "A Beacon of Hope". For the Hospital at the moment that is a most appropriate epithet and in that sense I am pleased to report that we are slowly being able to offer a wider range of treatments in Gaza, including one laser treatment in the last week. We remain concerned over the level of backlog that is building up and therefore the increased level of work awaiting us when hostilities cease (in spite of that seemingly ever further away). We continue with our 3 phase plan to bring services back to where they were, but the times scales forever lengthen.

We are putting together a plan for a very glamorous funding raising event on 5th Feb 2025 in London at the Mansion House, the home of the Lord Mayor of the City of London, which is perhaps the most prestigious dining venue in the City. Details to follow on our website soon but if you have an appetite to attend (and come with one) please note the date in your diaries now.

In spite of all the horrors on the news, the other beacon is that all the Hospital staff and their families are safe and we should pray that remains the case.

Once again I thank all Brother Knights for their continued interest and support for our work.


